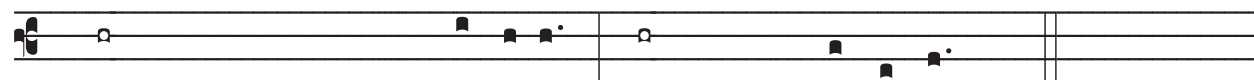


Second Sunday after Easter

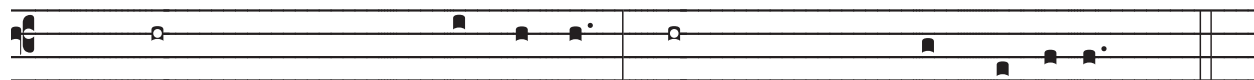
