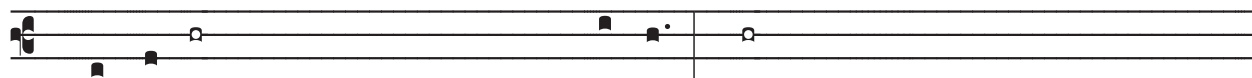
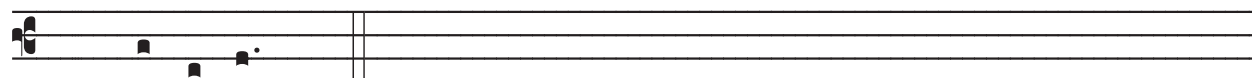


Third Sunday after Easter

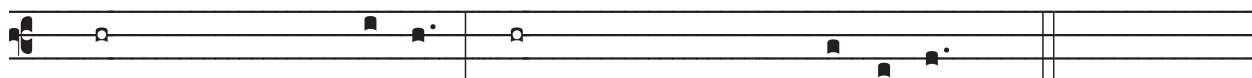
