

Introit (Is. 48: 20)

Vocem jucunditátis annuntiáte, et audiátur, allelúja: annuntiáte usque ad extrémum terræ: liberávit Dóminus pópulum suum, allelúja, allelúja.

Vs. (Ps. 65: 1-2) Jubilate Deo, omnis terra, psalmum dícite nómini ejus: date glóriam laudi ejus.

Vs. Glória Patri, et Fílio, et Spirítui Sancto. Sicut erat in princípio, et nunc, et semper, et in saécula sæculórum. Amen.

Vs. (Ps. 65: 1-2) Shout with joy to God, all the earth, sing ye a psalm to His Name: give glory to His praise.

Vs. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Declare it with the voice of joy, and make it known, alleluia: declare it even to the ends of the earth: The Lord hath delivered His people, alleluia, alleluia.

Allelúja. Vs. (Joann. 16: 28) Exívi a Patre, et veni in mundum: íterum relínquo mundum, et vado ad Patrem. Allelúja.

Alleluia, alleluia.

Vs. Christ is risen, and hath shone upon us, whom He redeemed with His blood.

Alleluia.

Alleluia. Vs. (John 16: 28) I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again I leave the world and go back to the Father. Alleluia.

Offertory (Ps. 65: 8-9 & 20)

Benedícite, gentes, Dóminum, Deum nostrum, et obaudíte vocem laudis ejus: qui pósuit ánimam meam ad vitam, et non dedit commovéri pedes meos: benedíctus Dóminus, qui non amóvit deprecatióem meam et misericórdiam suam a me, allelúja.

O bless the Lord our God, ye peoples, and make the voice of His praise to be heard: Who hath set my soul to live, and hath not suffered my feet to be moved. Blessed be the Lord, who hath not turned away my prayer, nor His mercy from me, alleluia.

Communion (Ps. 95: 2)

Cantáte Dómino, allelúja: cantáte Dómino et benedícite nomen ejus: bene nuntiáte de die in diem salutáre ejus, allelúja, allelúja.

Fifth Sunday after Easter

Sing unto the Lord, alleluia; sing unto the Lord, and bless His name; show forth His salvation from day to day, alleluia, alleluia.
