Vs. The Lord hath reigned over all the nations; God sitteth on His holy throne. Alleluia.

Alleluia. Vs. (John 14: 18) I will not leave you orphans: I go away, and I come unto you, and your heart shall rejoice. Alleluia.

Offertory (Ps. 46: 6)

Ascéndit Deus in jubilatióne, et Dóminus in voce tubæ, allelúja.

God is ascended with a shout, and the Lord with the sound of a trumpet, alleluia.

Communion (John 17: 12-13 & 15)

Pater, cum essem cum eis, ego servábam eos, quos dedísti mihi, allelúja: nunc autem ad te vénio: non rogo, ut tollas eos de mundo, sed ut serves eos a malo, allelúja, allelúja.

Sunday after the Ascension
