

### **Introit (Ps. 17: 19-20)**

Factus est Dóminus protéctor meus, et edúxit me in latitúdinem: salvum me fecit, quóniam vóluit me.

Vs. (Ps. 17: 2-3) Díligam te, Dómine, virtus mea: Dóminus firmaméntum meum et refúgium meum et liberátor meus.

Vs. Glória Patri, et Fílio, et Spirítui Sancto. Sicut erat in princípío, et nunc, et semper, et in saécula saeculórum. Amen.

### **Alleluia (Ps. 7: 2)**

Allelúja, allelúja.

Vs. (Ps. 7: 2) Dómine, Deus meus, in te sperávi: salvum me fac ex ómnibus persecúentibus me et líbera me. Allelúja.

Alleluia, alleluia.

Vs. (Ps. 7: 2) O Lord, my God, in Thee have I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me. Alleluia.

### **Offertory (Ps. 6: 5)**

Dómine, convértere, et éripe ánimam meam: salvum me fac propter misericórdiam tuam.

Turn to me, O Lord, and deliver my soul, O save me for Thy mercy's sake.

### **Communion (Ps. 12: 6)**

Cantábo Dómino, qui bona tríbuit mihi: et psallam nómini Dómini altíssimi.
