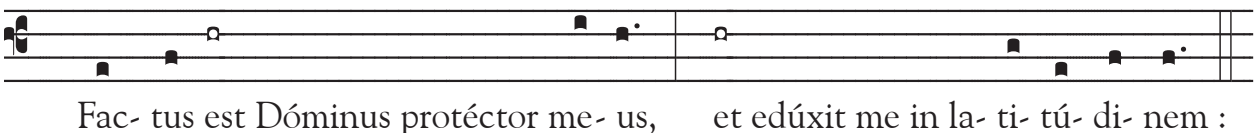
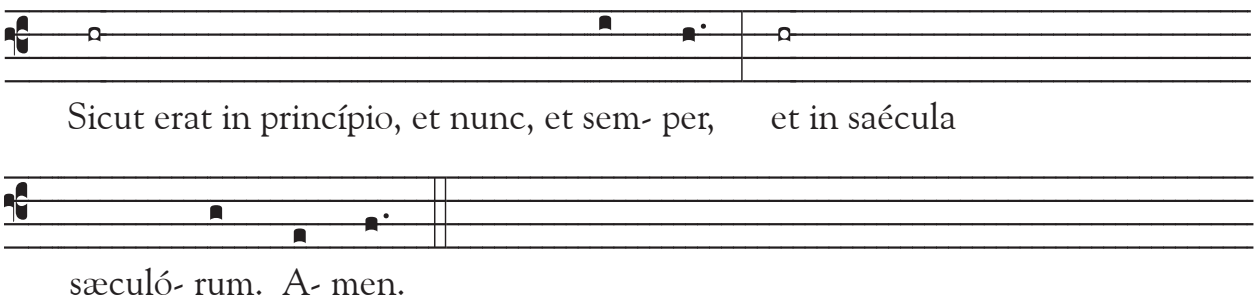
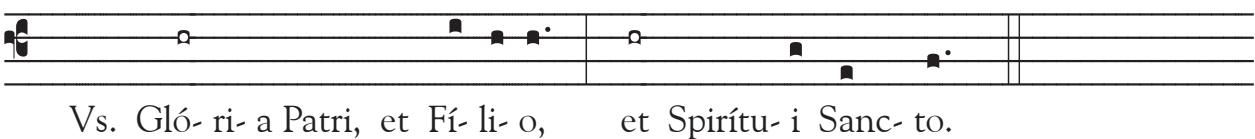
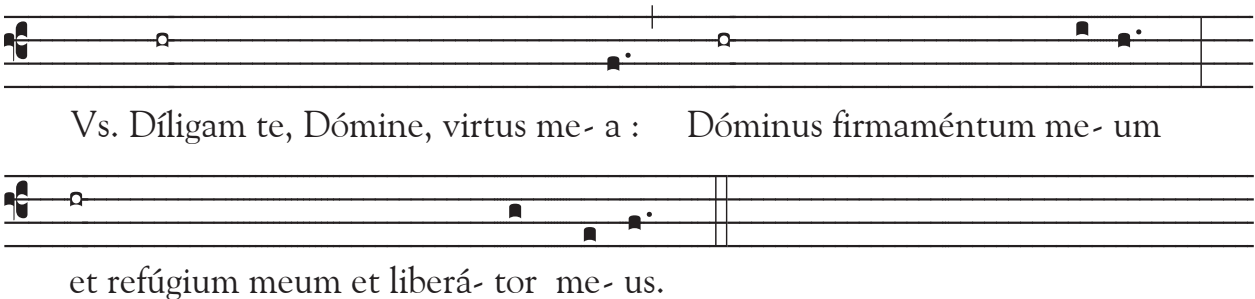
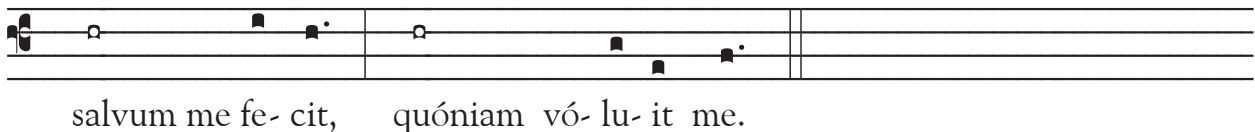
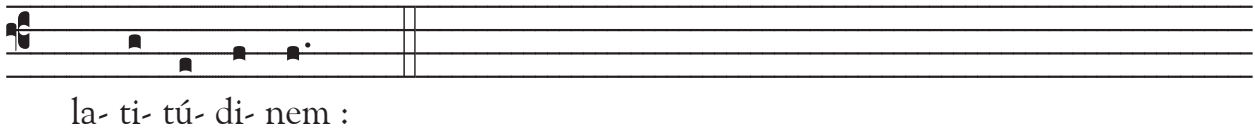
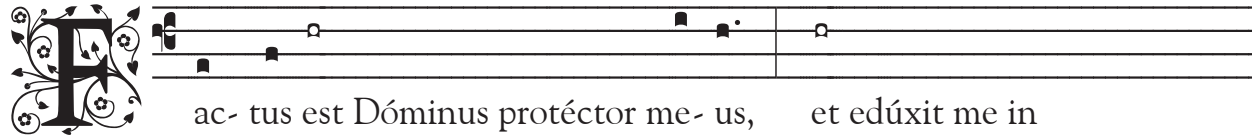



## Second Sunday after Pentecost
