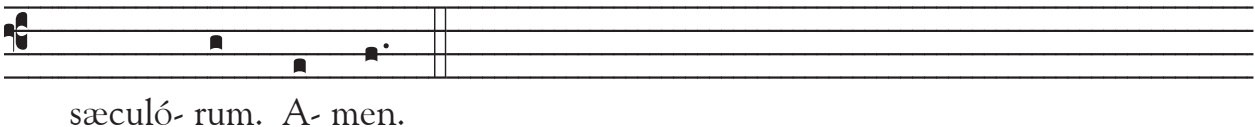
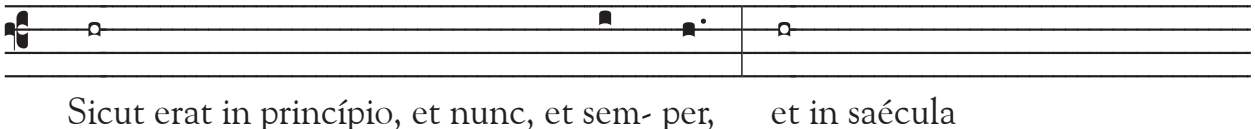
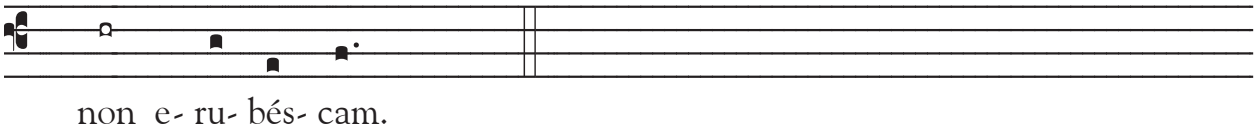
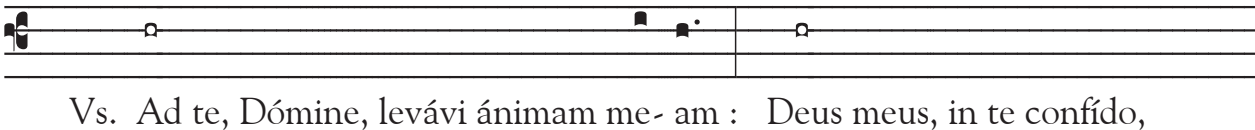
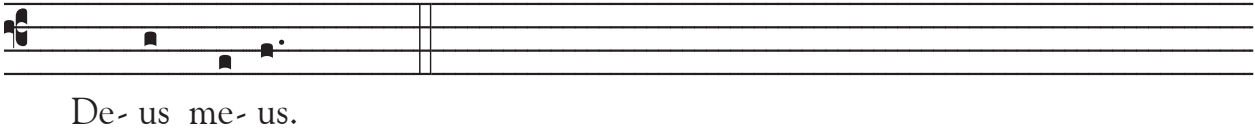
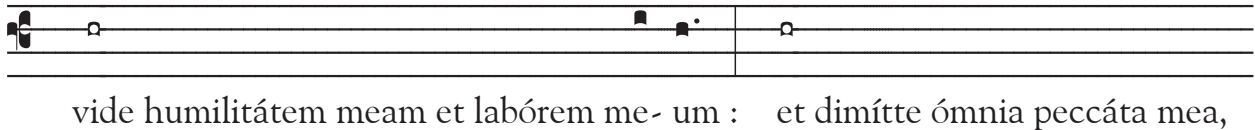
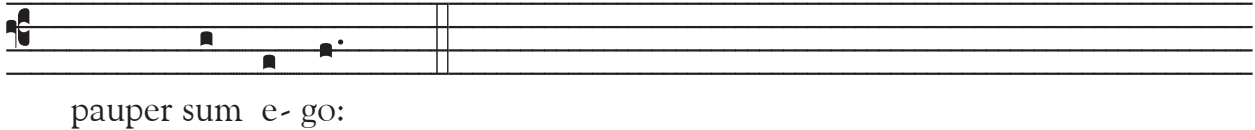
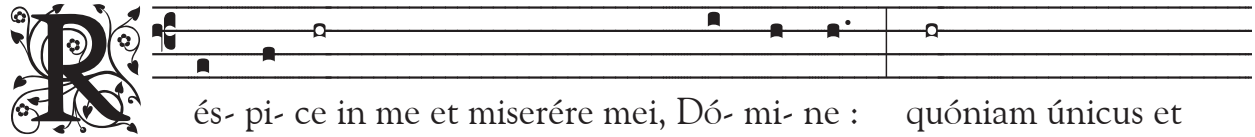



Third Sunday after Pentecost
