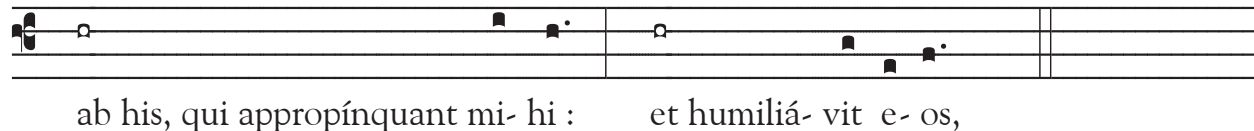
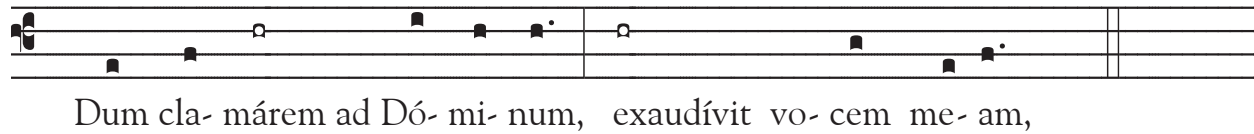
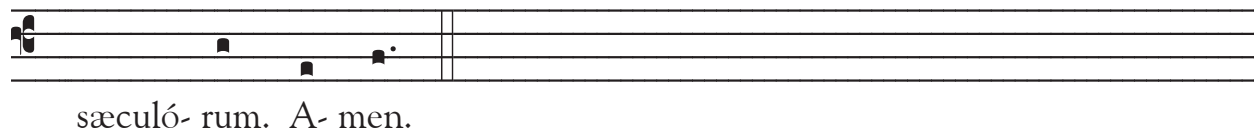
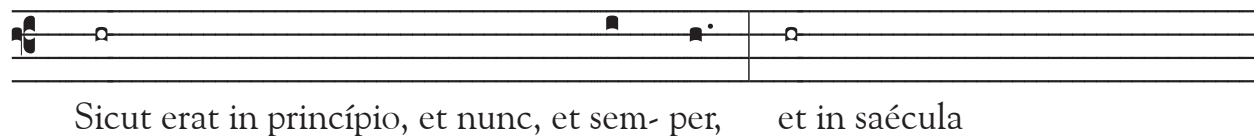
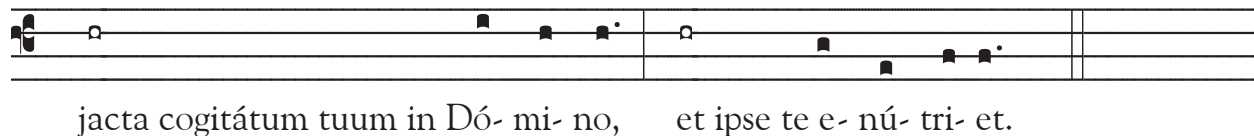
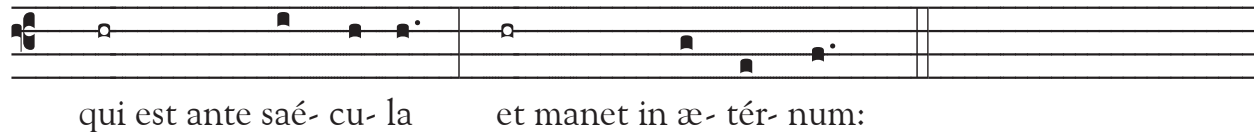
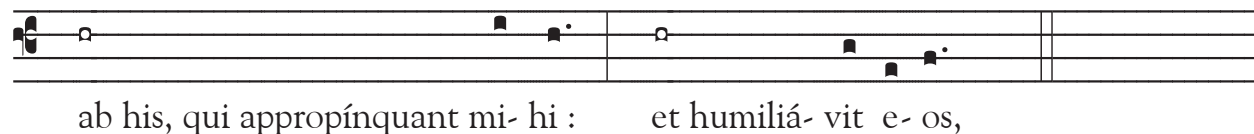
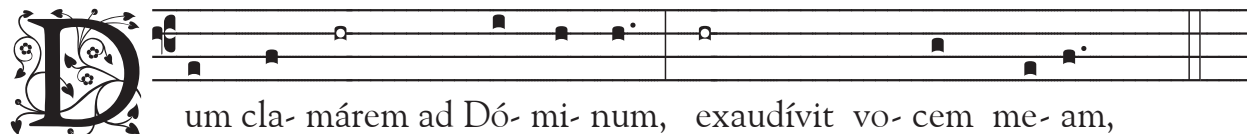


10th Sunday after Pentecost
