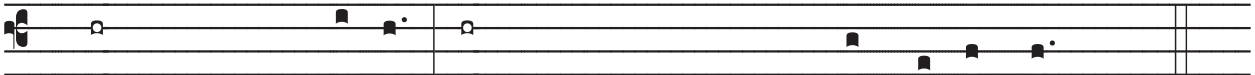


20th Sunday after Pentecost

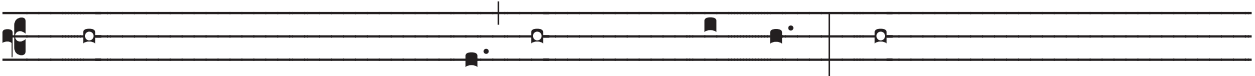
